

Pukaha Mount Bruce School Visits

We'd love to have your school come to Pukaha Mount Bruce



The following is a guideline for your days activities.

10.00am Arrive at Pukaha Mount Bruce

Your guide will welcome you to Pukaha. There is an opportunity to have a toilet break and morning tea in the Huia room before we get started.

The Huia Room will be your base for the day. Your group can gather here, safely store bags and belongings and it can be a spot to eat lunch if it's wet outside.

10.30am Takahe Story & viewing *Listen to the story of our Takahe and their importance to Pukaha Mount Bruce. See our Takahe up close as our rangers feed them.*

11.15am Aviary Walk /Kiwi House visit *A Guide will accompany your group as you explore the aviaries and the park.*

Manukura, our rare white North Island Brown Kiwi and her friend Turua, North Island Brown Kiwi, are easily and clearly observed in the Kiwi House.

The Theatre screens excellent short films that provide background information on the conservation breeding programme, restoration and trapping in the Reserve and the cultural heritage of Pukaha Mount Bruce.

12 noon Explore the Interactive Gallery *A great opportunity to reinforce what we see in the park and learn about Pukaha and its history through our interactive and static displays.*

12.15pm Lunch time *Visitors are able to purchase food and drinks from our on-site café if they wish. We can also provide a range of school lunch options— please enquire at your time of booking . Also a chance to visit the toilets before our afternoon adventures!*

1.00pm Eel Feed *Take a wander through the park to watch the eels being fed— adults may even have the chance to help feed these amazing fish!*

1.30pm Meet the Kakas *We visit the "Kaka Circus" area and see who we can see. Final opportunity to experience the forest.*

2.00pm *Return to Visitor Centre and farewell.*

Numbers: To get the best experience we prefer only one school group per day with the maximum number of children being fifty (50). If your numbers exceed this please ring us to discuss options. We provide 1 guide to every twenty-five (25) children.
