# PROTECTING THE FUTURE OF OUR ENVIRONMENT AND NATIVE WILDLIFE

Pūkaha National Wildlife Centre is a captive breeding facility and visitor centre that straddles the Wairarapa and Tararua regions. Located in a protected forest, Pūkaha is home to endangered wildlife including brown kiwi, pāteke (brown duck), whio (blue duck), takahē, kōkako, kākā, orange-fronted parakeet, tūturuatu (shore plover), and tuna (longfin eels).

Our well-respected and highly successful captive breeding programme has enabled large numbers of native species to be reintroduced into the wild.

One of our great success stories is the recovery of several endangered native bird species, including kiwi, kākā and kōkako.

Working in partnership with Rangitāne – our local iwi, we share a goal to ensure our birds, other wildlife and native flora continue to thrive in the forest (ngahere). Our collective vision is to welcome future generations into a pristine and protected forest, abundant with native species - brimming with biodiversity and accessible for all to enjoy.

As a registered charity, public funding is not enough to cover the costs of running all of our conservation, education and trapping programmes. We rely on the generosity of outside organisations like yours to continue our work.

#### **OUR WORK**

### **Captive Breeding**

One of our first partnerships was with our neighbour, Elwyn Welch who is credited with pioneering captive breeding on his Mt Bruce farm to save the takahē. Today, Pūkaha spans an area of 942 hectares of restored forest and continues its captive breeding work for native species.

We're focused on re-establishing populations of native birds across New Zealand. We hatch, raise and contribute to successful releases of threatened species all over Aotearoa. Our facilities, our experience and expertise mean Pūkaha is a critical contributor to nation-wide conservation programmes that bring birds back from the brink of extinction.

#### **Forest Restoration**

Our aim is to restore the mauri (life essence) of the forest. To achieve this we're removing plant and animal pests, increasing diversity of species for native flora and fauna and furthering our captive breeding efforts.

# Education and Hands-On Learning – Te Wānanga Taiao

Pūkaha's Environment and Ecology Programme - Te Wānanga Taiao incorporates mātauranga Māori - Māori knowledge, along with hands-on nature-based learning. It opens up environmental education programmes for all ages - from schools through to tertiary students. The purpose-built wānanga facility provides an environment to facilitate biodiversity research, thereby contributing to a wider body of science and knowledge.


